During our 4th Quarter Technology Classes, students will have the opportunity to disassemble and reassemble various pieces of technology such as laptops, desktops, and more. This is a fun and engaging way to learn about engineering, product design and electronics!

Interested students must agree to the following rules and sign below. They must also obtain permission and a signature from a parent or guardian below.

RULES

1. Misconduct of any kind will not be tolerated during disassembly and reassembly of electronics.
2. Screwdrivers and other tools may not be used for anything other than their specific purpose.
3. Tools and electronics may not be carried around the room and must remain on their designated table.
4. Power tools may not be operated unless the teacher is present.
5. Damage to tools or equipment must be reported to the teacher immediately.
6. Tools and electronics will be properly cleaned up and stored at the end of each class.

Common Concerns:

Shock Risk?

Batteries and power units have been removed from devices. Devices will sit for at least 7 days before being opened, to ensure no possibility of shock.

Harmful Materials?

No batteries will be part of the lessons. No monitors will be taken apart due to shock from stored voltage and harmful fluorescent backlight chemicals.

Will my kid start taking things apart around my house?!?

They will be encouraged to not do so, without parent/guardian permission! :)
